I. Motion to call meeting.

Lesleigh made motion to go into executive session at 1:10 pm to discuss disciplinary. Shannon seconded with all in favor.

- Disciplinary was discussed during the Executive Session

Lesleigh motioned to come out of Executive Session at 2:04 pm Shannon seconded with all in favor.

II. Disciplinary committee report (Jack Spatafore & D.C. Offutt)

a) Case No. 2008-01 (Original complaint received 04/01/08, 18 months = 10/01/09)

b) Case No. 2010-01 (Original complaint received 03/16/10, 18 months = 09/16/11)

- Hearing was held October 26, 2010

c) Case No. 2010-03 (Original complaint from the board 07/01/10, 18 months = 01/01/12)

- Hearing date November 18, 2010
- Lawyer requesting a consent agreement
- D.C. motioned to suspend the license immediately on the basis that the board has sufficient evidence that the licensee presents a risk and danger to the public if continuing practicing. The suspension will run until we are able to have a Hearing. Lesleigh seconded the motion with all in favor.

d) Case No. 2010-04 (Original complaint from the board 06/17/10, 18 months = 12/17/11)

- Hearing was held October 26, 2010

- e) **Case No. 2010-05**
 - Received adverse action.
 - Disciplinary committee found probable cause.
 - Shannon made motion to do a Consent Agreement requesting a suspension of license until disciplinary is taken care of in any other jurisdictions, has no pending discipline in any other jurisdictions, and shows proof of good standing in KY. If the Consent Order is not accepted, it will go to a Hearing. D.C. seconded the motion with all in favor.

- f) **Case No. 2010-06 (Original complaint from the board 10/19/10, 18 months = 04/19/12)**
 - Received complaint.
 - Respondent has 30 days to answer.
 - Disciplinary Committee will investigate complaint.
